<p>▲Israelites kept Passover 2nd year after coming out of Egypt - Nu 9:5</p> <p>▲Second Passover instituted, Israelites in the wilderness of Sinai - Nu 9:6-11</p> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; width: fit-content; margin: 10px auto;"> <p>Other Passovers</p> </div> <p>▲716 BCE Sabbatical Year (unsubstantiated) - Hezekiah reinstated Passover - 2 Chron 30:1-27 Kept 2nd Passover and DOUB, the remnant of those that escaped Assyrians (after fall of N.
